

## SHS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To receive a diploma and be considered a graduate of Scranton High School, a student must complete twenty-five (25) units of credit.

The following units are required:

4 Units – English	(one each year 9-12)
4 Units – Mathematics	(1-Algebra, 1-Geometry, 1-Algebra II, 1-Trig/Precal or College Trans Math or College Algebra)
3 Units – Social Studies	(1-World History, 1-American History, ½-Civics or ½-American Government, ½ Social Studies Elective)
3 Units – Science	(1-Biology) (1-Physical Science: Choose between Physical Science, Physics or Chemistry)
½ Unit – Physical Education	
½ Unit – Oral Communications (Speech)	
½ Unit – Fine Arts (Choose between art, choir, vocal music)	
½ Unit – Health Education	

TOTAL OF 16 UNITS OF REQUIRED CLASSES.

You MUST also have enough electives to reach a total of 25 credits for the class of 2013 and beyond.
