

Uniontown Teachers' Association Scholarship

Requirements:

The applicant must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

1. Plan to major in education
2. Received a 21 or better on the ACT.
3. Earned at least a 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
(That is the GPA needed as a minimum to enter most accredited education programs in Kansas.)
3. Be enrolled in college as a fulltime student with twelve (12) hours or more next fall.

Process:

1. Complete the two-page application included here.
2. Submit an updated resume with the application.
3. Return the complete application to the high school counselor by

March 12

Details:

1. Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced on Senior Awards Night in early May.
2. Depending upon the number of qualified applicants, the scholarship amount varies from \$100 to \$200.
3. The scholarship money will be paid directly to the recipient once proof of enrollment is given to the UTA treasurer.
4. A committee of Uniontown Teachers' Association members will select the recipient(s).
