August 21, 2018 – 7:00pm Jr. High Room #218

A work session was held from 6:18pm-7:03pm. Topics discussed were board self evaluation goals with some goals modified and policy GCBA-R, Instructional Staff Salary Schedule. The board agreed to strike out the bullet that limits a new teacher hired at a maximum salary of step 16. The policy will read a new teacher can be placed on the salary schedule at the appropriate steps with no limits.

The regular meeting of the Holyoke Board of Education was called to order at 7:08pm with all Board members in attendance except Dustin Sprague.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Principal Recap of Beginning of School

Mr. Shane Walkinshaw and Mrs. Andrea Kammer gave a recap of the first few days of school. Mrs. Kammer started out with 300 students on the 1st day. This is down just a few. She said with the movements of teachers to other classes, she will keep a close eye on the numbers of students in each class after going to only 2 teachers in Kindergarten and 2nd grade. She noted that at least 80% attended back-to-school night. The staff at the elementary really embraced the social/emotional training during inservice days and have already implemented it into their classrooms. Mr. Walkinshaw was able to walk around at back-to-school night and introduce himself to parents and students. The first day of school assembly was very energized. One of the main focus this year will be building security.

Athletic Director Report on Beginning of Fall Sports

Mr. John Baumgartner gave a report on the beginning of the fall sports season. The discussion about 6th graders moving up to play JH sports if the numbers were low was started with the administration and school board.

Policy GCBA-R, Instructional Staff Salary Schedule Regulations
