This year, pumpkins in all colors and textures, will be placed amongst our special scarecrow exhibit. Be sure to make time to peruse Scarecrows at the Gardens, a collection of festive, kooky, spooky, and creatively handcrafted scarecrows, all created by Gardens staff, local artists, businesses, students, organizations and individuals. Come early and cast your vote for your favorite.

During The Great Pumpkin Hunt, intrepid explorers can search for golden pumpkins hidden throughout the central gardens—those who unearth the prize gourds will be rewarded with family memberships, guest passes, Gardens Aglow tickets, or gift cards to the Garden Shop.
