Parents,

In August of 2020, the Bryan County School System will open a new elementary school in south Bryan County. The facility is currently under construction off of Warren Hill Road near Richmond Hill Middle School. The school is being built to house 1,200 students in grades Pre-K through 5th. We are pleased to report that construction is proceeding on schedule, and we anticipate the facility will be ready to occupy in July 2020.

Bryan County Schools will begin the process of redistricting for the elementary school in November. Attendance lines will need to be drawn in order to:

- Accommodate the opening of the new elementary school in August of 2020
- Relieve overcrowding at McAllister Elementary
- Plan for future growth at Richmond Hill Primary, Richmond Hill Elementary, and Carver Elementary
