

Mound City R-2 Board Meeting Report 10-16-19

Sianna Meadows and Kaite Selleck presented Cheerleader information and activities. Dara Young and Cameron Laukemper recapped volleyball season to date. Sianna Meadows also presented some season highlights for Cross Country. Dylan George, T.J. Hopkins, Tyler Phillips, and Parker Staples reflected on the football season and the remaining schedule.

Mrs. Becky Reinig (Music Education) and Mrs. Lisa Caton (Special Education) commented on their classroom activities, objectives and responsibilities during staff input. Also during the communications section, the board reviewed Federal Programs. A Parents as Teachers report was given. Ms. Flint presented written information as part of the Special Education Review. Mr. Eaton discussed the federal programs budget for this year. The dollars are narrowly defined for Title 1 and technology purposes. The principals presented student achievement from last spring's standardized testing.

The board approved the consent agenda containing minutes of the previous meeting and financial report.

The board tabled the 2018-19 audit report as it was not finished by the auditor as of the meeting time.

Ms. Flint commented the principals both met with a Regional Professional Development representative to align dates and topics for upcoming teacher in-services. Several parents (20 families) met October 15 with their students. This was an Accelerated Reader event where they read a book, took a quiz and lastly ate brownies with ice cream. The STAR testing program has been really helping kids with choosing books to enable students with maximum comprehension as well as confidence. Parent/Teacher Conferences will be October 17th from 1 – 7 p.m. Ms. Flint will be attending an Annual Performance Report meeting in St. Joseph.

Mr. Miles explained the difficulty in reporting some required information to DESE regarding graduates. Intervention lunch seems to be working since classroom assignments are regularly completed on time. The instrumental program seems to be going very well and commented as to Mrs. Reinig do a great job.

Mr. Eaton mentioned the opening of a custodial position and recommended Pam Kirkendoll for the position. The board approved 6-0.
