The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is an optional timed multi-aptitude test that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military and other career paths. This test will help you to discover your strengths and interests to map out a post-secondary plan. This test is given at over 14,000 schools and Military Entrance Processing Stations (MEPS) nationwide and is developed and maintained by the Department of Defense.

The ASVAB will be administered at both Marysville-Pilchuck and Marysville Getchell campuses and takes up to three hours to complete. This test will be available to all sophomores, juniors, and seniors who sign up on a first come first serve basis (limited spaces available). Registration is required.
