Dear Parents and Guardians,

It is hard to believe that we are heading into the last week of the first quarter. This week you may be seeing your student study for upcoming assessments or completing projects and/or other assignments as the quarter draws to a close. I would encourage you to speak to your student about his or her performance and ask the following questions to help prepare for the second nine weeks: Are you happy with your performance? If not, what can be done moving forward? What goals can you make to help ensure academic success? Whose help might we need to seek out if there are any concerns?

If it is determined that your student may need help, study tables are now available every Thursday after school until 3:15 p.m. with National Honor Society students in the Quatman Room. Mrs. Janowski and Mrs. Harruff can also help pair students with peer tutors during the school day or before or after school. Many teachers also have office hours after school where they are available for additional tutoring.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you how a student's cumulative GPA is calculated. A student's GPA is only calculated when credit is earned in a class, so at the end of a semester or at the end of a year long course. A student's GPA is NOT an average of the four quarters. The final grade is assigned a numeric value. The numeric value of the final grade is calculated and that is how we arrive at a student's GPA.
