The Board approved Lunch checks totaling \$28,612.19, Escrow checks totaling \$11,520.00, Cooperative checks totaling 37,325.72 and Activity checks totaling \$30,168.32.

Mr. Alexander give Mrs. Gilsdorf's report. Grandparents Day was held at the lunch room. Parent-Teacher conferences were very well attended at the elementary with 98% total. There were 10 children who attended the pre-school session. Mr. Alexander and Mrs. Gilsdorf attended the Safety Summit in Kearney. Fire Safety Prevention week has held with the Kindergarten students going to the fire hall and a presentation

was held for the rest of the students. Maps testing is complete. Upcoming events include Red Ribbon Week Oct. 28 through Nov 1st, fall break is Oct. 31st and Nov. 1st. ECOC will meet on Nov. 6th at 7:30 a.m. Title 1 lunch will be on Nov. 7th at 11:30. There will be Pre-school on Nov. 7th at 7:00 p.m. The Veteran's Day program will be held on Nov. 11th and math night for grades 3-6 will be Nov. 14th at 7:00 p.m. Amanda Doering has been hired as a cook in the cafeteria.

The Activity Director report included that Braden Eisenhauer has been selected to the Believers & Achievers. Unified Bowling practice has started. Bloomfield hosted the D-4 Cross Country tournament. The girls cross country team qualified as a team and Addison Smith and Cory Martinson qualified for the meet to be held in Kearney on Oct. 25th. Mr. Hamm attended the Lewis & Clark conference administration meeting. Volleyball sub-districts will begin on Oct. 28th. Football playoffs start on Oct. 31st. Jayden Hochstein and Mrs. Lange will be attending National Honor Choir on Nov. 7th – Nov. 9th in Orlando, FL. FFA students will be attending National FFA convention Oct. 30th through November 3rd.

The Superintendent reported that 2 board members will be attending the NASB/NCSA state conference from Nov. 22 – 22nd in Omaha. Federal and state applications are currently in progress. Mr. Alexander has had a preliminary meeting with the Bloomfield Education Assoc. regarding negotiations for the 2020-2021 school year. Safety Inspector, Craig Frerichs, was here to inspect the buildings. He was impressed with the remodeling and improvements that have been done. High School parent-teacher conferences were attended by 85% of parents. This is up from past years. NWEA Maps testing is completed for the fall session.

Committee reports included: Americanism/Civics, Administrative Review, Board Policy and Procedures, Negotiations/Staff Relations, Transportation and Budget. The Building and Grounds committee met to discuss future ADA and Title IX needs.

The Board discussed fundraising. Country Market employees would be happy to meet with groups and organizations in an effort to support the community's local vendors. The Superintendent evaluation materials will be handed out in November. Mr. Alexander had a preliminary sketch of improvements that would address ADA and Title IX. It was also mentioned that when posting on social media to keep it positive.
