### WHAT:

PA CareerLink® Youth Workforce Specialists will guide you through a series of activities and experiences to help you

- Learn about yourself, your interests and your skills
- Gain volunteer and work experience
- Make connections between the classroom and careers
- Create a portfolio linked to your post-high school goal: college/training, employment or military
- Develop skills to obtain a job, keep a job and compete in today's economy.

## WHEN:

Youth will participate in Bridges to the Future for up to 2 years to prepare you for life after high school. The following activities and experiences will build on each other:

- Summer work experience before your junior year
- Quarterly meetings and activities with your PA CareerLink® Workforce Specialist throughout your junior year
- Summer work experience, internship or your own job before your senior year
- Monthly meetings and activities with your PA CareerLink® Workforce Specialist throughout your senior year
- Placement assistance after high school graduation
- Up to 1 year of follow up to make your transition successful

#### WHERE:

Most activities will take place at your school during a time that works best with your schedule. Other activities and experiences may occur at your local PA CareerLink® office or other location.
