Re: Asbestos Management Plans

In keeping with the State Department of Education's directive and the Federal Asbestos Hazardous Emergency Response Act (AHERA), The Granby Board of Education is required to annually notify you that asbestos management plans are available for public inspection.

All known asbestos-containing materials have been removed from our schools except for a small amount of glue encapsulated inside walls or behind chalkboards during the renovations at Kelly Lane Intermediate School. This small amount of non-accessible material poses no health concerns unless disturbed by future renovation projects.

All activities involving the monitoring of asbestos-containing materials in the Granby Public Schools are included in these plans. Every three years, the public schools are re-inspected for asbestos as required under AHERA regulations. In addition, the school district keeps complete and accurate records of any asbestos activities including abatement, operational and maintenance fiber release incidents and related activities.

The asbestos management plans are available for public inspection at each school building.
