

## Fort Davis Independent School District Parent Involvement Policy

The Fort Davis Independent School District is committed to the goal of providing quality education for every child. To this end, we want to establish partnerships with parents and with the community. Everyone gains if the school and the home work together to promote high achievement by our children. Neither home nor school can do the job alone. Parents play an extremely important role as children's first teachers. Their support for their children and for the school is critical to their children's success at every step along the way. Fort Davis ISD intends to include parents in all aspects of the district's programs. The goal is a school-home partnership that will help all students succeed.

### Parental Involvement in Developing the Policy

Parents, members of the community, and school staff will be involved in the design and implementation of the Parent Involvement Policy. The Fort Davis ISD District Improvement Committee will discuss the design and the implementation of the Parent Involvement Policy.

#### Annual Meeting for Title I Parents

Fort Davis ISD uses Title I funds to provide school-wide services for all students at the elementary school. This campus will hold at least one meeting annually to review the Title I guidelines and services offered through the district. Copies of the district's Parent Involvement Policy and the Parent-Student-Compact will be distributed at the meeting. Parents will be encouraged to become involved in revising and updating the policy as needed. Meetings will be scheduled at a convenient time and location for all concerned parties.

#### School-Parent-Student Compact

In accordance with Title I regulations, each school must share the responsibility with parents for high student performance by developing a school-parent compact. This compact will provide an outline to enable the school and the parents to share responsibility for student performance and success. This compact explains how students, parents, and staff will share responsibility for student performance and success. #### Parental Involvement Opportunities

Fort Davis ISD will support many varied ways of parental involvement as it strives to develop and maintain an optimum learning environment for all students. Each school and family will develop and maintain parent involvement activities best suited to meet the individual needs of everyone involved. Opportunities will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Spanish translators will be provided for parents as needed.
- Information will be provided in Spanish when needed.
- Parents may contribute through volunteer programs.
- Parents may contribute by creating a supportive home environment.
- Parents are encouraged to participate in parent-teacher conferences.
- Parents are invited to help plan and conduct classroom activities and events.
- Parents may participate by attending school meetings.
- Parents are invited to serve on committees.
- Parents are invited to share their input about school.
- Parents are encouraged to apply for substitute teaching positions.
- Parents are invited to eat meals with their children.



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### Matching Programs to the Needs of Our Community

Through community representation on school committees, the community will be consulted in the design, development, and implementation of the Title I program. Parent and student needs will be assessed through a variety of formats and measures. The district will welcome and promote parental suggestions and community input.

#### Staff/Parent Communication

Parents will be informed of school activities through various avenues of communication throughout the year; they will be consulted in the design, development, and implementation of the Title I program.

Newsletters, conferences, personal contacts, and written notices will be utilized to establish and maintain an open line of communication.

All staff members will be trained in positive communication activities as well as effective ways to work with parents, students, and members of the community. Campuses will maintain records of parent contacts throughout the school year.

At the beginning of each year, each teacher will communicate the learning goals and objectives to parents. All students will be expected to work toward mastering these goals and objectives. Fort Davis ISD recognizes the fact that some students will need accommodations and/or extra assistance to achieve their full potential; these will be provided to students, as appropriate, through educational services offered through the district.

#### Evaluation

Campus committees will annually review and evaluate all aspects of the parent involvement program. Additionally, each campus committee will be instrumental in annually assessing the effectiveness of parent involvement activities conducted at the campus level. The results of the annual review will be evaluated and incorporated into the district action plan and each campus plan, as appropriate. The district committee will revise the Parent Involvement Policy based on the results of the annual review.
