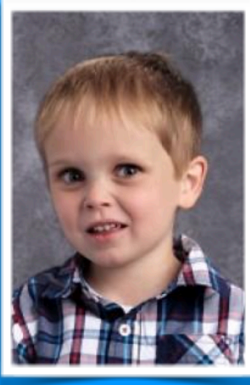
Pick-A-Time online Scheduler is now open!
