HALL OF FAME CRITERIA

Cedar Bluffs High School Athletic Hall of Fame

The Cedar Bluffs High School Athletic Hall of Fame was established to formally honor the memory and contributions of the many outstanding athletes, coaches, and supporters of our athletic programs. The Hall of Fame serves as a symbol of our appreciation of the excellence, honor, and devotion displayed by these celebrated individuals and teams.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1) A maximum of four individuals will be inducted into the Hall of Fame during any given school year.
- 2) Any individual with a demonstrated interest in the Cedar Bluffs High School Athletic Programs may submit a nomination. An individual may NOT nominate himself or herself for induction.
- 3) All nominations will be presented to the Hall of Fame selection committee.
- 4) Once an individual has been nominated, their nomination will remain active for a period of five years or until such time they are inducted into the Hall of Fame.
- 5) The selection committee shall consist of six Cedar Bluffs High School Sports Enthusiasts.
- 6) To be approved for induction, a candidate must receive unanimous support from the selection committee.

INDUCTION/NOMINATION CRITERIA

Athletes Criteria for Induction

- 1. Athletes will be eligible for induction five years after graduation.
- 2. The athlete must have attended a Cedar Bluffs High School for a minimum of two years and be a graduate of a Cedar Bluffs High School.
- 3. The athlete must have conducted himself/herself in such a way as to reflect honor on the school and must have exhibited those qualities of character and standards of conduct consistent with their status as a role model to the community. Cedar Bluffs High School reserves the right to remove any individual from the Hall of Fame for personal conduct, which reflects discredit upon the school.
- 4. Nominee should, at minimum, have been an All-Conference/All-Area selection or held or set a school record at one time.

Coaches Criteria for Induction

- 1. The individual must have coached a varsity team at a Cedar Bluffs High School for a minimum of five years.
- 2. The individual will become eligible for the Hall of Fame immediately upon their retirement or five years after leaving employment with the Cedar Bluffs Public School District.

Community Member Criteria for Induction

- 1. Eligibility of outstanding contributions will be at the sole discretion of the selection committee.
- 2. Candidates must have made outstanding contributions or offered extraordinary services to the students/athletes and the athletic programs at Cedar Bluffs High School.
- 3. Candidates need not be graduates of Cedar Bluffs High School to be eligible for induction.
