ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART
DEFENDANT'S MOTION TO MODIFY DESEGREGATION PLAN


Pursuant to an opinion issued this day, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Choctaw County School District's motion to modify desegregation plan [10] is GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART, as follows:

- (1) Grades 9 through 12 of Ackerman High School and Weir Attendance Center¹ shall be consolidated at the current site of Ackerman High School;
- (2) Grades 7 through 8 of Ackerman High School, Weir Attendance Center, and French Camp Elementary shall be consolidated at the current site of Ackerman High School;
- (3) The new District-wide entity composed of grades 7 through 12 shall be designated Choctaw County High School;² and
- (4) The District's elementary school structure for grades pre-K through 6 shall remain unchanged.

¹ Grades 9 through 12 at Weir Attendance Center are composed of those students residing in the Weir attendance zone, as well as those students residing in the French Camp attendance zone who do not attend French Camp Academy.

² As noted in the opinion *supra*, in the event the District elects to treat the middle school as a separate entity, the two entities shall be designated Choctaw County High School and Choctaw County Middle School, respectively.
