Dear Parents, Students, Families, & Friends,

Hard to believe we are already a quarter of the way through the 2019-2020 school year! Lansing School District 158 has experienced a number of success stories in Quarter 1 already, including completion of the Final Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for our new Calvin Coolidge Elementary School, implementation of a district-wide fresh food service through A'viands, Memorial Junior High School's Baseball Team winning the Regional Championship with an undefeated regular season, Oak Glen Elementary School presenting at the Illinois Principals Association State Conference, and receipt of numerous grants for classroom, library, and writing supplies. **#158Strong** indeed! The purpose of this letter, however, is to remind you about several important safety procedures we have in place to keep all of District 158's students safe.

If a parent, guardian, or emergency contact visits the Main Office of one of our schools, please be reminded that you will be asked to show photo identification (ID) in order to sign out your child. This is a required procedure even if you have visited the school before. Signs are placed in our offices indicating this. Your credentials will be checked against the information in our student management system to ensure we are releasing the student safely. Please help keep our children safe by having a photo ID available when you visit any of our offices. You will not be required to scan your ID through Hall Pass unless you are going to enter student areas of the school (e.g. classrooms, etc.). The following forms of ID may be used:

- Government issued photo ID such as a state driver's license, passport, state ID, or U.S. military card
- U.S. permanent resident card or internationally issued photo ID from another country

Thank you for your assistance in helping our office staff to ensure that students are released safely to parents, guardians, and emergency contacts. Please contact your child's school with any questions.
