Part B: Planning Process

It is our goal to have an ongoing process for school improvement planning that includes review, revision, implementation, and assessment. In creating the school improvement plan, several small meetings are held in conjunction with the district's curriculum committee meetings.

Okaw Valley High School Improvement Goals 13-14

Goal 1 – Okaw Valley High School teachers will create Type III assessments aligned to the Common Core to be delivered in all subjects two times per year beginning in 2014-2015. (Tests are Developed and were given by all subjects the first week of school) 9-26-14.

Goal 2 – Okaw Valley High School curriculum will be aligned to the Common Core standards by 2013-2014 and implemented beginning 2014-2015 school years. (All Core Subjects Aligned except Social Science to English) 6-3-14 **** 10/29/14 – I talked with Mr. Lawler about aligning to the common core in English and he has all of the tools and information to make this happen. It will be completed by March.

3/20/15 – We are aligned to the common core in social studies (ELA).

Goal 3 – Okaw Valley High School staff will collaborate together to develop a more accurate and in depth attendance policy that will increase attendance by 5% at the high school level starting in the 2014-2015 school year. (New policy was adopted by the board (6/19/14).

- As of 12/17/15 – we had 52 kids miss 1 or less days excused and 22 more miss 0 days in the first semester.

Okaw Valley High School Improvement Goals 14-15

Goal 1(Formative/Informative Assessments) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will use Type III assessments that are aligned to the Common Core. These tests will gauge student growth and be given twice during the 14-15 school year.

- All high school teachers gave pre-tests at the beginning of the year.
- 10/22/14 – Talked to the staff about the growth model and how the Type III will be used.
- 10/29/14 – During the curriculum meeting teachers talked about the different assessments they will be using for the growth model.

Goal 2 (Curriculum Alignment) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will meet once a month in curriculum teams to discuss; strengths, weaknesses, problems, and other issues pertaining to their particular subject. Middle school teachers will be involved in vertical alignment once a semester to share ideas during the 14-15 school year.

- 8/27 – First Curriculum Meeting of the Year – curriculum groups filled out templates in regards to common core/alignment/concerns.
- 10/29 - All teachers were put into different groups. They had a template that was specific to their curriculum that they filled out. It was a good opportunity for teachers to brain storm and think outside the box.

- **11/26 – We had a vertical curriculum day at OVHS with the middle school. All groups filled out templates and discussed curriculum topics important to our district. The meeting was utilized very well.**

Goal 3 (Grade Advancement) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will meet once a month to talk about failing students. By using the MTSS system of supports we will keep 90% of the Okaw Valley High School student population from failing classes.

Okaw Valley High School Improvement Goals 15-16

Goal 1 (Formative/Informative Assessments) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will use Type III assessments that are aligned to the Common Core. These tests will gauge student growth and be given twice during the 15-16 school year. Teachers will put the information in a data collection program to gauge student growth.

- **9/2 – All teachers have done a test run on their pre/post tests and entered the scores in the data collection program.**
- **12/17 – Teachers turned in data from their posttests which reflected growth. They will be doing this again starting the 2nd semester with a pre-test.**
- **1/15 – Talking about the growth model and type 3 assessments in the vertical curriculum meeting.**
- **3/24 – Talked to all the staff at SIP day.**

Goal 2 (Student Growth) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will meet once a month in curriculum teams to discuss; the growth model and implications for the next year. School year 16-17 will be the first year the growth model will be used in conjunction with teacher evaluation. The goal is to have every teacher with a growth model plan to begin the 16-17 school year.

- **9/2 - Curriculum groups talked about the growth model and what they are doing in their class during their curriculum meetings.**
- **10/14 – Curriculum groups met and discussed the growth model tool.**
- **12/17 – Teachers turned in growth model data from the 1st semester with data logged in the growth model template.**

- 1/15 – The vertical curriculum groups met and discussed their specific assessments and the implications for the fall.
- 3/24 – Talked to all the staff at SIP Day. Mr. Forline’s presented about the growth model at OVMS.

Goal 3 (Grade Advancement) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will meet once a month to talk about failing students. By using the MTSS system of supports we will keep **93%** of the Okaw Valley High School student population from failing classes.

Okaw Valley High School Improvement Goals 16-17

Goal 1(Student Growth Model Implementation/Advancement) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will use Type II and Type III assessments that are aligned to the Common Core. These tests will gauge student growth and be given twice during the 16-17 school year. Teachers will put the information in a data collection program to gauge student growth and will redesign if necessary. The growth model portion will combine with the performance rating to get a summative score. Teachers who are not being evaluated this year will continue to evaluate their Type II and Type III tests and make changes if needed.

- Teachers began giving pre/post tests and gave me the data to input into the growth model template.
- 10/3 /16 – I have met with all teachers and data has been entered into the growth model template for all.

Goal 2 (Community Connections) – The Okaw Valley team will continue to develop partnerships with area businesses that can impact our students positively. OVHS staff will put together an “OV At A Glance” once a month which will show the great things going on at OVHS. This will be sent to the local newspapers and social media.

- I met with Mr. Call and discussed an opportunity for his journalism class to develop a newsletter that would go out once a month and highlight the great things going on at OV. This would be in addition to the monthly newspaper.

Goal 3 (Grade Advancement) – Okaw Valley High School teachers will meet once a month to talk about failing students during our GLT. By using the MTSS system of supports we will keep **94%** of the Okaw Valley High School student population passing all classes on average, during the course of both semesters. Also, we are implementing an **88%** goal for all students **passing all classes with C’s or better.**
