Teach To: Athletic Events

Goal: To create a student body that is courteous and positive at sporting events.

Rationale: Students will learn that good sportsmanship is expected at all athletic events.

Expected Behavior

Respect

- Use kind words and gestures
- Show good sportsmanship (no booing or yelling at players, coaches, opponents, or officials).
- Clap when your team does well, not when the other team does badly.

Responsibility

- When in the gymnasium, watch the game & support our team from the bleacher.
- When watching outside sports, stay behind the rope (football) or fence (baseball).
- Throw your trash in the trash container. Clean up after yourself.

Safety

- Stay off playing surfaces/areas
- Playing football during the game happens on the practice field.
- Walk in the gyms and lobby areas.
- Use the stair step area when coming up or down the bleachers.

Positive

Negative

Almost

Uses positive words to encourage players

Yells negative things at opposing team

Gets mad and yells at officials some

Claps when our team does good

Claps at mistakes of visiting team

Claps some at other's mistakes

Stays in the bleachers to watch game

Runs around during the game

At halftime runs around

Throws away trash properly

Throws trash on the ground/floor

Hits the trash can most of the time

Walks on bleachers/uses bleacher stairs

Runs across bleachers

Walks, but doesn't use stairs

Walks in gym/commons area

Runs around the gym area/commons

Walks in gym, but runs in the halls

Provide Practice Opportunities – I do – We do – You do

Use reward system in Activities areas, - provide honey-bee cards when students are using the appropriate behavior.

When students forget guidelines – Re-teach the behaviors and practice them.
