Teach To: Classroom

Goal: To create a cooperative learning environment

Rationale: Learning is more apt to happen in a classroom where everyone is respected and valued.

Expected Behavior:

Respect:

- Give me “5” – 2 eyes, 2 ears & 1 mouth
- Treat others the way you want to be treated
- Raise your hand
- Work quietly – not distracting others
- Help others learn
- Address adults appropriately – Mr., Mrs., Ms., Coach

Responsibility:

- Be prepared for class – bring appropriate materials
- Use materials & time appropriately
- Do you best – give it your best efforts
- Turn in your work on time
- Use good manners – say please and thank you
- Do what will help you and others be successful
- Continue working when a visitor enters the room

Safety

- Use kind words and actions
- No harm to any one on the inside or the outside
- Always use bubble space

Giving the Teacher “5”	Not paying attention to the teacher	Most of the time “Giving 5”
Using the Golden Rule	Being mean to other students	Being mean to just one other student
Working quietly	Being very disruptive during work time	Occasionally being loud during work time
Bring all books and work to class	Forgetting books and assignments	Remembering books but forgetting homework
Uses time wisely - organized	Wastes a lot of time – unorganized	Sometimes gets off-track
Always gives a good effort	Usually just does the minimum	Occasionally wastes some time
Is courteous and always kind	Does not get along with teacher/classmates	Usually is courteous and kind
Stays out of other’s bubble space	Is always in someone else’s face	Once in a while annoys others
Never intentionally harms others	Does not care if he hurts others	Occasionally is insensitive

Provide Practice Opportunities – I do – We do – You do
