School Admission/Residency

Resident Affidavit

This form is to be completed by the person who is a resident of the Town of Blackstone or Millville and whom the child who is seeking enrollment to the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools is residing with.

I _____, swear under oath, that the following information is true:

1. _____, a child of school age, is living with me at _____ (circle one) _____ (address), Blackstone/Millville, MA

2. I understand that temporary residence of a child in the Town of Blackstone or Millville, **solely** for the purpose of attending the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools is not considered a "residency."

3. I understand that the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools reserve the right to investigate the reasons why this child is residing with me and does/does not reside with a parent or legal guardian.

4. I understand that I am required to notify the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools or the above student's school, in writing, of any change in said student's address within five (5) calendar days of such change of address.

5. I understand that this *Affidavit* will be relied upon by the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools for the purpose of determining the above student's eligibility to attend the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools on the basis of residency. If said student is enrolled in the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools based upon the information provided and it is subsequently determined that the student does not actually reside in Blackstone or Millville, I understand that the student's enrollment in the Blackstone-Millville Regional Schools will be promptly terminated and I will be liable to the Blackstone-Millville Regional School District for the student's tuition for the full academic year(s).

6. I understand that all students must reside in the Town of Blackstone or Millville (Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 76, sec. 5). Every person shall have a right to attend the public schools of the town where he/she actually resides, subject to the following section. No School Committee is required to enroll a person who does not actually reside in the town unless said enrollment is authorized by law or by the School Committee. Any person who violates or assists in the violation of this provision may be required to remit full restitution to the town of the improperly-attended public schools. No person shall be excluded from or discriminated against in admission to a public school of any town, or in obtaining the advantages, privileges and courses of study of such public school on account of race, color, sex, religion, national origin or sexual orientation.
