Tutoring

Tutoring help can provide the individual attention and extra reinforcement needed by learners in a variety of situations. Tutoring can be beneficial to the tutor and the person being tutored, but it does not replace good first teaching. The purpose of tutors will be to support and reinforce classroom instruction provided by the teacher.

Tutoring may be provided through cross-age models involving student-to-student assistance or through the use of adult volunteers. School personnel will identify appropriate roles for tutors and will provide orientation to help them carry out the roles effectively and in accordance with school guidelines.

Criminal background checks will be conducted prior to the first time the tutor works with students. Traffic background checks, where appropriate, will be conducted. The District reserves the right to conduct additional checks periodically thereafter.
