

HOME LANGUAGE SURVEY

Upon enrollment, every student or parent/guardian should be given a Home Language Survey. This survey will be used to determine which students should be tested for English proficiency. If a language other than English is marked for any of the numbers 1-4, the student must be assessed for his/her English proficiency to determine whether or not the student needs English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) support services. The assessments approved by Kansas State Department of Education to determine eligibility for ESOL services include: The Language Assessment Scales (LAS)/LAS LINKS/Pre-LAS, the IDEA Proficiency Test (IPT)/Pre-IPT, the Language Proficiency Test Series (LPTS), and the Kansas English Language Proficiency Assessment (KELPA)/KELPA-P. If a student scores below proficient/fluent in any of the language domains: listening, speaking, reading, or writing, s/he is eligible for ESOL services. Please complete one form for each child.
