DIRECTIONS FOR WHS HOME MEET: 218 ASH ST., WELLSVILLE, KS
66092 ACROSS FROM ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

DIRECTIONS TO ANDERSON CO:

TAKE I35 S TO US 59 S. GO APPROX 20 MILES TO GARNETT.

AT THE FIRST STOP LIGHT (RIGHT AS YOU ENTER TOWN) GO LEFT. CONTINUE UNTIL YOU REACH THE SWIMMING POOL (ON THE LEFT). TURN LEFT AFTER THE SWIMMING POOL AND BEFORE THE ARMORY BUILDING.

THEY RUN AT THE GOLF COURSE WHICH IS JUST PAST THE FOOTBALL FIELD.

DIRECTIONS TO WAMEGO: (WAMEGO COUNTRY CLUB 1900 COUNTRY CLUB DR, WAMEGO, KS)

TAKE KS33 NORTH TO 56. TURN LEFT (WEST) ONTO 56 HWY. TURN RIGHT ONTO US75N TOWARD TOPEKA. MERGE ONTO I-470W. MERGE ONTO I-70W. TAKE THE EXIT TOWARD KS-99 N. TURN RIGHT ONTO KS-99 N. TURN LEFT ONTO 8TH STREET. SLIGHT LEFT ONTO COUNTRY CLUB DRIVE.

DIRECTIONS TO RIM ROCK:

TAKE 1061 N TO EUDORA. GO LEFT (WEST) ON K10 TO LAWRENCE. TURN RIGHT (NORTH) ON MASS ST. GO ACROSS THE RIVER (NORTH) ON KS 24/59. TURN RIGHT ONTO E 1400 RD/CR-1045. (THERE WILL BE SIGNS THAT SAY RIMROCK TO FOLLOW) TURN LEFT ONTO 13TH STREET. TURN RIGHT ON REPUBLIC ROAD. TURN RIGHT ONTO BURNETT LANE.

DIRECTIONS TO CENTRAL HEIGHTS:

TAKE I35 S TO US 59 S. AFTER YOU GO THROUGH PRINCETON YOU WILL GO AROUND A CURVE ON 59S. BEFORE YOU GET TO THE SECOND CURVE TAKE A LEFT ON ELLIS ROAD. GO EAST ON ELLIS ROAD, THE SCHOOL IS ON THE LEFT.

ALTERNATIVE DIRECTIONS THROUGH RANTOUL: TAKE 33HWY SOUTH TO KS68 HWY. TURN RIGHT ON KS68. GO 1 MILE TO VERMONT ROAD, TURN LEFT. TAKE VERMONT ROAD (GO THRU RANTOUL) GO TO JOHN BROWN ROAD. GO RIGHT ON JOHN BROWN RD. GO TO OREGON ROAD, TAKE A LEFT. GO 2 MI TO ELLIS ROAD, GO RIGHT. SCHOOL IS ON THE RIGHT.

DIRECTIONS TO LOUISBURG: (Lewis & Young Park)

TAKE 33 HWY SOUTH TO KS68. TURN LEFT (EAST) ON KS68. 68 RUNS THROUGH LOUISBURG. GO THROUGH TOWN AND YOU WILL HIT A 4-WAY STOP. TURN LEFT (NORTH) GO APPROX 2 MILES AND TURN LEFT (WEST) @271st ST. (Just past Mossman Lumber Co. on your right). ABOUT A MILE AND TAKE A RIGHT (NORTH) ON JINGO RD. YOU WILL CURVE BACK TO THE WEST AND YOU WILL SEE THE LIGHTS FOR LEWIS AND YOUNG PARK.
