We are pleased to quote as follows:

- 1) Supply and install (2) main traveler panels and valance, fabric to be inherently flame retardant KM "Crescent" polyester Velour, color to be determined. Panels will be sewn with 50% fullness using grommet-in pleats. Top hem to have 3 ½" Nylon webbing with brass grommets and s-hooks, 12" turn-backs at center stage, 4" side hems and a 4" bottom hem with a separately sewn internal chain pocket with #8 zinc plated jack chain. Two panels 24'-0"W.
- 2) Supply and install (4) traveler panels (2 sets), fabric to be "Ovation" inherently flame retardant polyester velour, color black. Panels will be sewn with 50% fullness using grommet-in pleats. Top hem to have 3 ½" Nylon webbing with brass grommets and s-hooks, 12" turn-backs at center stage, 4" side hems and a 4" bottom hem with a separately sewn internal chain pocket with #8 zinc plated jack chain. Four panels 24'-0"W.
- 3) Supply and install (3) border curtains, fabric to be "Ovation" inherently flame retardant polyester velour, color black. Panels will be sewn with 50% fullness using box pleats. Top hem to have 3 ½" Nylon webbing and supplied with black tie lines. Three panels 44'-0"W.
- 4) Supply and install (8) 4pr. side leg curtains, fabric to be "Ovation" inherently flame retardant polyester velour, color black. Panel will be sewn with 50% fullness using box pleats. Top hem to have 3 ½" Nylon webbing and supplied with black tie lines. Eight panels 6'W
- 5) All labor and equipment to re-hang existing tracks and battens.
- 6) All labor and equipment to install new curtains complete.

- 1) All fabric is certified inherently flame retardant.
- 2) Contractor removed some of the existing tracks and pipe battens. They are on the stage and need to be re-hung
- 3) The existing hanging points are Inco chain which does not meet today's standards.
- 4) We recommend that the 58 hanging points be upgraded to  $\frac{1}{4}$  " 7x9 cable with trim chains at a cost of \$1,740.00
- 5) Terms: Net 30 Days.
