Re: Public Act 101-0515 amends Section 5/14-8.02f and creates a new Section

5/14-8.02g of the Illinois School Code to require that all Illinois school

districts and special education cooperatives:

Starting in 2020-2021 and annually thereafter, within 20 days from the beginning of the school year post on district website and include in Parent/Student Handbooks, the following:

Students with disabilities may receive related services as part of their individual education programs (IEPs). The Paw Paw School District will maintain related service logs that record the type and number of minutes of the related service(s) administered to such students. Copies of any related service logs will be available to parents/guardians at their child's annual review IEP meeting. Parents/guardians of students with disabilities may also request copies of their child's related service logs at any time.

Note: This Public Act also amends the Illinois School Student Records Act to include related service logs as part of a child's temporary school student records that must be maintained by school districts and special education cooperatives.
