Hello, Paw Paw! Here is the down low with our students' art creations lately: in Kindergarten, our little friends discovered how crayon wax can resist watercolor paint! Ask them what happened when they painted over their drawn gourds. In 1st grade, we are continuing our primary colors with a geometric bat collage! They can tell you what "geometric" means! In 2nd grade, form and texture were displayed with our clay jellyfish. Our 3rd graders were just introduced to artist Hokusai. They are seeing how foreground, middle ground and background are shown in his landscapes. 4th & 5th grade are imagining a tiny world in their mixed media terrariums! Form is discussed (3D art) with their clay creatures inside. 6th through 8th graders found out how flexible our copper art sheets can be through the Mexican hojalata tin styles. Using embossing and relief, our kids came up with some pretty amazing tin art! Your students of all ages are demonstrating so much talent!
