Spring means that the 4th Quarter is upon us, the last nine weeks of the school year. May will be here before we know it, and very soon we will be celebrating with our 8th graders as they graduate on May 24th!

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you that have completed the 5Essentials survey we sent out last month. Paw Paw students in grades 3 - 8 will be taking the Illinois Assessment of Readiness tests beginning after spring break. The Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) is the state assessment and accountability measure for Illinois students enrolled in public school districts. IAR assesses the New Illinois Learning Standards incorporating the Common Core and will be administered in English Language Arts and Mathematics to all students in grades 3-8.

The Paw Paw Board of Education has two open seats and will be interviewing potential candidates for appointment on the Board at the March 21 Board meeting. 


