**Dear drama students and parents:**

We are taking our one act play, Two Fronts, to state competition!! Yay!! We are so excited!

Here is the pertinent information that you will need:

- The State Class B one-act play competition is on Nov 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019 in Jamestown
- Our first round performance is on Monday, November 25<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm Central Time at the University of Jamestown (Reiland Fine Arts Center 6000 College Ln, Jamestown, ND 58405).
- We will leave on Sunday, November 24<sup>th</sup> at 1 pm from the school. Dickinson students: we can arrange to pick you up if you talk to one of the directors.
- We will be staying at the Fairfield Inn in Jamestown [930 25th St SW, Jamestown, ND 58401 (701) 952-6300] on the nights of Sunday Nov 24 and Monday Nov. 25
- Students will be eating at the University of Jamestown (where the competition is held) for noon meals on Monday and Tuesday. If parents come to the competition and want to eat there, please contact the university yourself at (701) 252-3467
- Students are given \$20 per day (for two days) to help cover the cost of meals. \$7.25 of that is already used each day for eating at the University, leaving you with \$12.75 for your evening meals. If you feel you need more than that or wish to shop at the mall or buy other snacks, please bring additional money.
- On Sunday night, we will eat at Applebee's at 7:30 pm CST (reservations are made)
- On Monday night, we will eat at Pizza Ranch at 7:00 pm CST (reservations are made) The price for the buffet there is \$12.36 before tax, so your \$20 that day will be spent.
- We will be giving each student \$13.15, which is what they have left after two meals at \$7.25 and Pizza Ranch buffet of \$12.36, on Sunday night at Applebee's. Any expenses after that are at their own cost.
- On Tuesday afternoon we will leave for home and will stop somewhere to eat fast food. This is not covered in your per diem, so be prepared to pay for that meal.
- There will be a complimentary continental breakfast at the hotel Monday and Tuesday morning for the students to take advantage of.
- There is a swimming pool (water park) at our hotel, so be prepared for that if you wish to enjoy that.
