Here's an update about our bond program. We're making great progress!

New Elementary PreK-6 Building & 7/8 Gym

- Exterior finishes and glass installation continue.
- We're moving away from temporary heat in the building.
- We're finishing the main entrance and staircase.
- We're starting to install the carpet, and painting continues.
- The wood flooring for the gym is here and awaiting installation, and we are installing some of the gym equipment, including basketball hoops and wrestling mat lifts.

Athletic Improvements

At our board meeting on February 21, the board voted to move forward with the athletic stadium upgrades as well as the new practice fields. In case you missed it, the scope of the athletic improvements includes:

- Replace playing surface with new grass field and proper field drainage and expand surface width from 210 feet to 230 feet to allow for soccer field use.
- Replace track with new six-lane track and flip orientation to connect to Lyons St.
- Relocate track and field events (shotput and discus) to new location.
- Install new perimeter track fencing (4 feet tall, vinyl coated).
- Remove berm around perimeter of field.
- Remove visitor bleachers and replace with new aluminum bleacher system.
- Upgrade home bleachers, make concrete repairs, replace railing, adjust stair height, replace retaining wall and install new terrace viewing area.

- Expand plaza space at south end of stadium.
- Build addition to the east of the existing concessions/restroom building.
- Install new entry sequence and entry gate setup.
- Install new perimeter site fencing (6 feet tall, vinyl coated).
- Install new LED stadium lighting and poles.
- Install new stadium power locations.
- Upgrade sound system.
- Construct three new practice fields to the west of the stadium.
