NEBRASKA CITY APPLE CORPS BARBERSHOP CHORUS

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

To assist deserving high school graduates, from schools represented by members of the chorus, in the first year of their post-secondary education. These scholarships were established beginning in 1993.

The scholarships shall be awarded to graduating high school students who, in the judgment of the Board of Directors of the Nebraska City Apple Corps Barbershop Chorus, best meet the following criteria.

That he or she must have participated the entire year in either instrumental or vocal music or both during each semester of each of the four years of high school.

That he or she has a scholastic average of B or better after seven semesters of high school.

That he or she plans to pursue additional education beyond the 12th grade.

That he or she commands the respect and admiration of his or her peers, is a leader among leaders, seeks to instill confidence and spirit among his or her fellow students, and is looked upon as a person of high moral integrity.

Scholarships shall be paid directly to the post-secondary institution of the students choice as soon as they can prove matriculation to that post-secondary school.

Applications must be submitted to the Nebraska City Apple Corps no later than January 24, 2020. No applications will be accepted after this date.
