- 8. New Business and Administrative Reports/Updates:
  - a. Mrs. Fowler gave an enrollment update. A new student started the week of October 21 bumping the enrollment to 96 students. Hillsdale Prep will be the cover of a local parent magazine in November. At the last meeting the Board discussed finding out how many children reside in Hillsdale County. Mrs. Fowler looked up information from the last two censuses. In the 2000 census over 9,000 kids age 5-17 lived in Hillsdale County. In the 2018 census that number dropped to just over 7,000. The Parent Advisory Committee hosted another great event for Halloween. Instead of having a free event they charged for food and raised over \$300.00. The new committee seems to be working out great. At least one staff member attends every meeting and the new format has brought in some new faces. At the end of October we will be attending a fall fest hosted by HCISD and the Boo Bash. Hopefully this will help spread the word about Hillsdale Prep.
- 9. GVSU Update: Mr. Barker did not have an update. At the beginning of the meeting he spoke to the Board about the budget cut to charter schools.
- 10. Other Matters: Troy Reehl reintroduced himself to the Board. He is the Superintendent of the ISD and spoke about the importance of joining together as a county to educate all kids. He is working on a millage to increase special education funding. The ISD would receive the money

and distribute it out to the local schools. He is also working on writing another millage to fund the career tech center.
