PARENTS' RIGHT TO KNOW PROVISION

Did you know you have a right to know the qualifications of your child's teachers and paraprofessionals? Did you know that Allendale County Schools must notify you of your right to request information about the qualifications of your child's teachers and paraprofessionals?

As per ESSA, families may request information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's teachers, including:

- Whether the teacher has met State qualification and certification requirements for the grade levels and subject he/she is teaching;
- Whether the teacher received an emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived;
- What undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration;
- Whether their child receives help from a paraprofessional and,

if so, their qualifications.

Families may obtain information about their child's teacher by contacting the school or through the State Department of Education at:

Under the Policy tab select Federal Education Programs. Next select ESEA, Title II. Continue to Parent's Right to Know then Educator Qualification Search. You may search by teacher name or by location.
