# EGF Drivers Education Licensure Process:

#### Phase I: Permit

- 1. Students Complete 30 hours of classroom time
- 2. Complete their written permit exam
  - a. At EGF Sr. High
  - b. At the Park and Rec Maintenance Shop (No appointment necessary)
    - i. Wednesdays 10:00-11:15 a.m.
    - ii. (218) 308-2940
    - iii. 929 5th Ave. NE (Near Stauss Park)
- 3. Get their permit at the DMV (Hardware Hank)
  - a. Pass an eye exam, pay \$13.25, picture taken, Parent signature

#### Phase II: Provision License

- 1. Students are to drive 50 hours (15 at night) with parents
- 2. Complete 6 hours BTW (Late April August)
  - a. One of the EGF driver education teachers will call and make an appointment with you or your teen.
- 3. Class D Road Test
  - a. When teen turns 16 and has had permit for at least 6 months
  - b. At the Park and Rec Maintenance Shop (Appointment necessary!)
    - i. 929 5th Ave. NE (Near Stauss Park)
    - ii. Wednesdays 9:30 a.m. 3:00 p.m.

- v. Teen must bring:
  - 1. Permit
  - 2. White Card
  - 3. Proof of Insurance for vehicle
  - 4. Supervised Driving Log
  - 5. Proof of parent meeting attendance (if parent attended)
- 4. After passing go to the DMV (Hardware Hank)
  - a. Pay some \$\$\$, pass the vision test, take a picture, parent signature

### Phase III: Full Drivers License:

- 1. After 1 year accident/ticket free or when you turn 18 years of age you qualify for a full drivers license.
- 2. Go to the DMV (Hardware Hank)
  - a. Fill out appropriate paperwork
  - b. Pay \$\$\$
  - c. Picture is taken
