JULY 17th, 2018 – GRACE CITY

The Annual meeting of the Midkota School District #7 Board of Education was held on July 17th at 7:30 AM in the meeting room of the Schoolhouse Café in Grace City, ND. <u>Members Present:</u> President Vollmer, VP Utke, Laura Kulsrud, Ethan Stangeland, Shian Hoyt <u>Absent:</u> Shawn Adrian and Preston Hoffman. <u>Others Present:</u> Superintendent Mrs. Bilden, Business Manager Nikki Boote <u>Guests:</u> Louis Halvorson, JoAnn Black, Keith Johnson and Jason Otto

President Vollmer called the meeting to order at 7:30 AM and a quorum was established.

Additions to the Agenda: Mrs. Bilden would like to add: 1) 2018-19 Staffing and 2) Football Coop

MSC Hoyt/Kulsrud to approve agenda with additions and consent agenda to include the following: Minutes from the June 11th meeting.

There being no further business for the 2017-18 school year, President Vollmer wishes to thank Shawn Adrian for his years of service to the Midkota School District.

MSC Hoyt/Utke to adjorn this portion of the meeting at 7:35 AM.

Meeting was turned over to Business Manager, Nicole Boote, who called the meeting to order at 7:35 AM with the following board members present: Laura Kulsrud, Veronica Vollmer, Joel Utke, Ethan Stangeland, Shian Hoyt and Louis Halvorson. Others Present: Superintendent Mrs. Bilden Guests: JoAnne Black, Jason Otto, Keith Johnson. CCC Representatives Darrren Fenster and James Allred, Larry Carcoana from Zerr Berg arrived at 9:30 AM. N. Boote welcomed newly elected board member Louis Halvorson and presided over the election of the President for the 2018-19 school year.

A. <u>President:</u> Laura Kulsrud nominated Veronica Vollmer; Veronica Vollmer nominated Joel Utke. Hoyt moved, Stangeland seconded, that nominations cease for board president. Paper ballots were distributed to all board members by Business Manager Boote and then collected and tallied: Utke – 4/Vollmer - 2; Utke declared the President. On roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion carried.

The meeting was turned over to Board President, Joel Utke.

B. <u>Vice-President:</u> Laura Kulsrud nominated Veronica Vollmer for school board vice-president. Hoyt moved, Stangeland seconded, that nominations cease and a unanimous ballot cast for the Vice President. On roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried.

- C. <u>2018-19 Appointments:</u> MSC Hoyt/Vollmer to appoint Nicole Boote as Business Manager; Superintendent Mrs. Bilden as the 2018-19 GST Multidistrict Educational Services Representative, CDDLC Representative, Title I, REAP, ADA, DOT Drug & Alcohol Safety, Section 504 and Title IX contact. On Roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried.
- **D.** <u>Auditor:</u> MSC Kulsrud/Stangeland to hire Harold Rotunda as the 2018-19 Auditor. On Roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried.
- **E.** <u>Bank Depository:</u> MSC Hoyt/Vollmer to keep the official depository as is with Farmers & Merchants Bank for the General Fund, Activity Fund and Hot Lunch Fund, Bank Forward for the CDDLC Fund and Authorize the Superintendent and Business Manager to Invest Funds. On Roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried.
- **F.** <u>Official Newspaper</u>: MSC Vollmer/Stangeland that the official newspaper will be The Foster County Independent. On Roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried.
- **G.** <u>Pledge of Assets/Bonding</u>: The board reviewed the bonding of school officials and also the pledge of assets from F&M Bank and found them to be adequate.
- **H.** Set Meeting Dates & Times for 2018/19 School year: MSC Hoyt/Halvorson to set meeting date and times to the 2nd Tuesday of the Month at 7:30 AM. On Roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried. One exception will be the August board meeting will be August 7th at 7:30 AM in McHenry.
- I. <u>Committee Assignments</u>: MSC Kulsrud/Hoyt to approve the 2018-19 Committee Assignments as follows: Budget & Finance – Vollmer, Kulsrud, Utke; Buildings – Hoyt, Stangeland, Utke; Curriculum, Technology and Staff Development – Vollmer, Hoffman, Kulsrud; Sports Cooperative – Halvorson, Hoyt, Stangeland On Roll call vote, all voted yes. Motion Carried.
- J. <u>Mission Statement and Beliefs:</u> The board reviewed both the Midkota School District Mission Statement and Beliefs.
- K. <u>Hot Lunch/Activity Fees</u>: Hot Lunch and Activity Fees were reviewed and will remain the same for the 2018-19 school year. Past due Hot Lunch and activity bills were discussed.
- L. <u>2017-18 Financial Report & 2018-19 Budget</u>: Superintendent Bilden reported to the board that the deadline for submitting the 2017-18 Annual district financials has been changed to August. Both these items will be tabled until the August meeting.
- M. <u>Buildings</u>: Representatives from CCC and Zerr Berg will be here at 9:30 AM for a building progress update and will be moved to the end of the meeting.

- N. <u>2018-19 Staffing:</u> Mrs. Bilden presented a proposal for 2018-19 staffing of Athletic Director and High School Principal. An update on a 2nd grade teacher was also given. Board is in agreement that Mrs. Bilden should move forward on what she thinks is best for the district as long as within the 2018-19 Budget.
- **O.** <u>Football Co-op Letter</u>: Superintendent Bilden will follow up with GCC Superintendent Brown on the 2019 Football Co-op.
