PROPOSITION NO. 1

to acquire classroom furniture for the Elementary, as needed	\$66,000.00
to acquire and install technology equipment for the Elementary and Middle School, as needed	\$82,000.00
to perform security improvements at the Elementary and Middle School to include, but not be limited to: secure entrances, security cameras, doors and locks	\$60,000.00
to acquire and install HVAC for the 5 th and 6 th grade classrooms	\$60,000.00
to repair and/or replace HVAC equipment at the Elementary and Middle School, as needed	\$102,000.00
to construct and equip an administration building	\$220,000.00
to acquire and install secure fencing and perform improvements at the Elementary playground, as needed	<u>\$40,000.00</u>

PROPOSITION NO. 2

to acquire vehicles for pupil transportation	\$180,000.00
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Description of Unpaid/Unfinished Bonds Previously Approved by Voters of the Jurisdiction:

As of the 11th day of February, 2020, Independent School District No. 48, Bryan County, Oklahoma, has 2 General Obligation bond issue(s) outstanding:

\$2,400,000 Building Bonds of 2012, dated November 1, 2012 (\$810,000 outstanding in principal as of the 11th day of February, 2020); and
\$645,000 Building Bonds of 2018, dated October 1, 2018 (\$645,000 outstanding in principal as of the 11th day of February, 2020).

The School District has an additional \$6,695,000 in unissued building bonds authorized at an election held on the 23rd day of August, 2016. These bonds will be used to complete the construction, furnishing, equipping and/or acquisition of the new high school.

Construct and equip Junior High Classrooms and a Multi-Purpose Facility/Gymnasium (111 North 4th Street, Calera, Oklahoma)	\$2,400,000.00
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2018 Issue

Construct, furnish, equip, and/or acquire a New High School to include, but not be limited to: utilities, specialties, masonry and EIFS (407 Rose Hill Road, Calera, Oklahoma)
