SENIORS & JUNIORS: COLLEGE VISIT DAYS - 2 days allowed for seniors and one for juniors to visit college or career center/vocational program campuses. See Mrs. Gilliland or Mrs. Orr for a form that needs to be completed BEFORE your visit. It is highly suggested that you contact the school you wish to visit for an appointment.

SENIORS: FAFSA (your financial aid for career centers, vocational schools, or colleges) can be completed for the 2020-2021 school year beginning October 1st. The FAFSA is free and can be completed online at www.fafsa.ed.gov using your parent/guardians/ and/or your 2018 tax information. If you plan to start college in January (early graduates), you will need to complete two FAFSA's - one using the 2017 tax information and one using the 2018 tax information. FAFSA Help Nights to complete FAFSA for those who need assistance. FAFSA Help Nights will be held on Wednesday, Nov. 13th, Jan. 8th, and Feb. 12th. Senior and at least one parent should attend. Drop in anytime from 3:30 to 7:00. However, individual appointments can be made with Mrs. Gilliland if you need one.

SCHOLARSHIPS! Seniors - keep in mind that when applying to some colleges, you are considered automatically for some

scholarships. Other scholarships and other colleges may require you to complete an admissions application, a general scholarship application, and/or individual scholarship applications. Please read carefully on the websites or speak with an admissions counselor from that school for further information. Ask for help! Start early on all scholarship applications and complete before the deadline if possible.
