FEBRUARY ACT

If you are interested in taking the ACT on February 8, you need to have your registration in by January 10 to avoid late fees. Register online at www.actstudent.org. Fair Play's school code is 261035. If you have not used all your waivers, you may pick one up in my office—otherwise the cost is \$52.00.

OTC Bound? Follow this "to do" list!

If you are planning to attend OTC and have not yet applied, go to www.otc.edu and click on "Apply Online." The application is free. Once you receive your acceptance letter from OTC, double check that you are completing the required tasks on the checklist you receive in the mail.

One required step you will have to do next semester before you enroll in classes at OTC is attend a **STAR Session** at OTC to learn how to enroll in classes. I have scheduled a group date on **March 3 at 9 a.m.** and we will take a bus for those students who prefer to do this as a group instead of on your own. **PRIOR** to that STAR Session, a rep from OTC will work with you to help you prepare for the STAR session. That date will be on **February 26**, **5**th **hour**. If you are planning to attend OTC next year these are important dates for you to note!
