

SENIOR Check List

	Check in with your counselor, to make sure you're on track to graduate and fulfill college admission requirements.
	Sign up for the ACT and/or the SAT if you didn't take it as a junior, or if you aren't satisfied with your scores. (or if you've learned a lot since you last took it.) If you need help signing up for these tests, you can get assistance in the counselor's office. Also check to see if you qualify for a waiver!
	Check the eligibility requirements of the college or university you wish to attend. Review your test results and retest if necessary. If you have any questions on how to do this, check with the counselor's office during lunch or before/after school.
	Start asking for letters of recommendation from teachers, leaders of organizations or employers early.
	Begin your college essays if you haven't already; have a teacher, parent, or counselor checks your essay for editing before you submit your essays.
	Apply for admission at the colleges you've chosen; see the counselor for help if necessary.
	Request official transcripts be sent to the colleges for which you apply.
	Check your email to make sure the college has received your application, admission fees and transcripts.
