Policy Title: **Field Trips**

The Kelso School District recognizes that field trips are natural extensions of the curricular, co-curricular, and interscholastic programs. Field trips are opportunities for students to participate in activities and gain experiences that cannot be duplicated in the classroom or on the school site. The board of directors encourages appropriate, carefully planned field trips that lend to new learning and reinforce what has been learned at school.

Each student shall have an equal opportunity to participate in field trips that are taken by the student group. The availability of field trip opportunities for students is commensurate with the funds which can be allocated to support such activities.

The superintendent shall develop regulations for the operation of field trips which will provide for the safety of the student. Parent permission will be obtained before the student leaves the school.
