Policy Title: **Film and Video**

The Board believes that movies, videos, DVDs and other audiovisual materials are important tools in the educational process. At the same time, the Board believes that the use of movies and videos should be limited so that they are used legally and appropriately in achieving legitimate educational objectives. Therefore, classroom instruction may include the appropriate educational use of movies and videos that maximize and enhance classroom instructional time and foster community values. The superintendent or a designee will develop procedures regarding how and when movies and videos may be used as instructional materials to supplement approved course curriculum.
