Policy Title: **Distribution of Materials**

The board recognizes that nonprofit organizations may want to distribute materials in the school district that are non-curricular but that have social, recreational or educational value for students.

Any nonprofit group wishing to distribute informational material must first submit to the Superintendent or a designee a copy of the material for review and approval.

Informational materials to be distributed may also be reviewed and approved by the building principal and meet certain standards prior to distribution. The primary purpose of the standards is to prevent the exploitation of students by individuals or groups.

It is the responsibility of the Superintendent, in conjunction with the building principals, to draft procedures regarding this policy.
