Here are some tips to help your kids when they read.

WHEN I READ	T <u>HINGS I CAN DO TO</u> HELP ME UNDERSTAND WHAT I READ
Before I read:	WINT I KEND
• Think: What do I already know?	1. Sound out an unknown word.
• Predict: What do I think will happen?	2. Go back and reread the passage.
As I read:	
 Ask: Did I understand what I just read? 	 Look up the meaning of an unknown word.
 Were there any words I didn't understand? 	4. Read ahead and see if it makes sense.
	5. Ask a question and try to find the
• Was anything confusing?	answer.
 Can I retell in my own words what I just read? 	6. Slow down as I read.
After I read: • Summarize	 Do one or more of these things, or something that I've learned to understand what I read.
