- 1. Call to Order: Joe Fenbert called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. Those in attendance were Mr. Fenbert, Heather Muir, Joel McMahan, Dr. Zora DeGrandpre, Dr. Paul Farris, Angela Bowen, and Nancy Nebeker. Ricky Emerson was unable to attend. Mr. Fenbert led all in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 2. Changes or Additions to the Agenda: Dr. Farris requested that A., of School Board Operations be added, regarding the potential sale of the Packwood Real Property. Mr. McMahan made a motion to accept the addition to the agenda. Dr. DeGrandpre seconded. The motion passed unanimously, (4, 0).
