- 1. Call to Order: Ricky Emerson called the meeting to order at 5:33pm. Those in attendance were Mrs. Emerson, Joe Fenbert, Dr. Zora DeGrandpre, Joel McMahan, and Dr. Paul Farris. Mr. Fenbert led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mrs. Emerson requested that community members wishing to speak to please sign in.
- **2. Executive Session:** Mrs. Emerson requested 15 minutes for executive session. The board entered at 5:35pm to discuss RCW 42.30.110 (1g), review the performance of a public school employee. The board exited executive session at 5:50pm. No action was taken.
