The regular meeting of the Palmyra R-1 Board of Education was held on Tuesday, December 10, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. in the office of the Board of Education at 1703 South Main, Palmyra, Missouri.

The building principals gave their monthly building reports.

Kirt Malone reported on the recent board retreat/work session that took place on Saturday, December 7, 2019. Mr. Roger Kurtz, retired Executive Director of Missouri Association of School Administrators (MASA), facilitated the work session. The Board reviewed progress on annual goals that are a part of the District Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP). It was the overall consensus of everyone involved that the time was very beneficial to the board and administration.

Pride graduation is set for Sunday, January 12, 2020, at 3:00 in the Palmyra High School cafeteria.

In new business, Mr. John Hume, Band Director, discussed the need for new high school Band uniforms with the board. The current uniforms were purchased in 1995 and are deteriorating to the point where many are beyond repair. A replacement uniform was modeled for the board.

In other new business, the Board approved the application from Amy Bryan to submit for the Missouri School Board Association Belcher Scholarship.
