#### **REFUND POLICY**

Cancellations made prior to the second class may receive a full refund, less an \$8.00 service fee (on classes 3 days or less the refund will be prorated). No refunds will be given after the scheduled date of the second class. If a class is not filled or is cancelled, a full refund will be given. Refunds can take 2 weeks to process. #### PATHFINDER POOL

#### EARLY BIRD SWIM

**Passes are purchased at the pool.** Early Bird is designed for individuals who want to run/walk and/or swim before going to work or school. Running/walking will take place on the indoor track adjacent to the swimming pool. There is no charge to use the track.

#### ADULT/SENIOR CITIZEN SWIM

**Passes are purchased at the pool.** No registration is required. Adult Swim is designed for adults, (at least 18 years of age) and senior citizens to have the opportunity to use the pool. Swim noodles are available for use. Lifeguards can assist with instruction.

Aqua Tots and Babies is not offered in the winter sessions.

#### LEVEL 1 (4 vrs & older must be at least 38" from chin to floor)

Prerequisite: Should be comfortable in the water without a life jacket. We will be working on: Supported floating and kicking on front and back Intro to alternating arm action & turning over from front to back Water safety rules How to get help in an emergency Fundamentals of using a life jacket Reaching assists with and without equipment.

#### LEVEL 2 (5 yrs & older)

Prerequisite: Should be comfortable in the water without a life jacket and have instructor approval. We will be working on: Rhythmic breathing \( \Delta \) Combined stroke on front and back \( \Delta \) Turning over front to back and back to front \( \Delta \) Reaching and extension assists

#### **LEVEL 3/4**

Prerequisite: Children must be 42" to the chin. We will be working on: Increasing swimming skill competency ♦ Treading in deep water ♦ Continued work on backstroke, front crawl, breaststroke and kicks ♦ Practicing safety and rescue skills ♦ Jumping into deep water without a life jacket ♦ Diving from the side of the pool

Classes scheduled for 45 minutes have 40 minutes of water time and classes scheduled for 30 minutes have 25 minutes of water time. \*Spectators should remain in the bleacher area. Street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck. \*Boys over 4 1/2 years of age should use the boy's/men's locker room and girls over 4 1/2 years of age should use the girl's/women's locker room.

#### DIVING LESSONS-PATHFINDER POOL



Divers will learn proper approaches, takeoffs and the mechanics needed to begin and improve their diving. We will work on approaches and begin learning some of the basic dives. 

Pinckney Community Education Preschool program follows the State of Michigan Standards of Quality for Early Childhood Education. We provide a warm, nurturing setting that encourages children to learn through developmentally appropriate hands-on learning experiences. Our structured and literacy-rich environments allow children to explore the world around them, while they grow socially, emotionally, and academically. With learning concepts in math, science, language, literacy, music, and art, our students are exposed to many educational experiences. A Pinckney Schools preschool experience includes exploration with cooperative learning and playing with peers. Focused on kindergarten-readiness, our certified early-childhood teachers consult with our kindergarten teachers in order to provide children with important kindergarten-readiness activities, especially those which are focused on prereading and early writing experiences. Set within our district's elementary buildings, our students are exposed to and become familiar with what our quality buildings have to offer. We believe in a strong correlation between parental involvement and student educational success and, therefore, welcome parental involvement in our State of Michigan licensed classrooms.

#### THREE YEAR OLD-

This program is for children who turn 3 prior to September 1, 2020, potty trained (out of diapers and pull ups) and independent to use the bathroom. Three year old preschool meets two days per week: Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM. The cost for a full year is \$1170 plus a \$50 registration fee. This is payable in nine monthly payments of \$130. Upon registration a \$50 non-refundable registration fee is due.

#### FOUR YEAR OLD MORNING

This program is for children who turn 4 prior to September 1, 2020 Four year old preschool meets three, four or five days per week from 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM. The cost for three mornings a week: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday is \$1530 which can be billed in nine monthly payments of \$170. The cost for four mornings a week is \$1980 which can be billed in nine monthly payments of \$220. The cost for five mornings a week is \$2430 which can be billed in nine monthly payments of \$270. Upon registration a \$50 non-refundable registration fee is due.

#### FOUR YEAR OLD AFTERNOON

This program is for children who turn 4 prior to September 1, 2020. Four year old afternoon preschool meets three days per week: Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoon from 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM. The cost for a full year is \$1530 which can be billed in nine monthly payments of \$170. Upon registration a \$50 non-refundable registration fee is due.


