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School and Community

Maynard High School is a public 9-12 high school serving a total of 314 students. The class of 2023 includes 74 students. We are accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges. Maynard is a small town of approximately 10,000 residents situated 27 miles northwest of Boston.

Student Demographics

-Gender: 52.4% female, 46.6% male, 1% non-binary

-Free/Reduced lunch: 28.7% qualify in 2022-23

-Languages: 85.5% of students speak English at home, 6% Spanish, 5% Portuguese

Curriculum Features

-Chapter 74 vocational program for radio and TV production in conjunction with WAVM, the student-run radio and TV station

-Additional academic courses available through Virtual High School and dual enrollment, primarily through Middlesex CC and MassBay CC

-Senior project capstone course including research, writing, planning, and presentation skills; required for graduation

-9th grade elective rotation: For classes through 2023: Civics, Introduction to Capstone, Physical Education, and Health

-Programs for special populations: Special education study skills classes and vocational skills program; ESOL classes; OASIS program for social emotional student support

-Seal of Biliteracy designation through the Commonwealth of Massachusetts: 2022: 10 students, 2021: 5 students; 2020: 8 students; 2019: 5 students

Advanced Placement (AP)

AP courses are offered in Biology, Calculus AB, Chemistry, Computer Science, Drawing, English Language, English Literature, French Language and Culture, Physics 1 and 2, Spanish Language and Culture, Statistics, US Government, US History, and World History: Modern. Additional AP courses are available through Virtual High School.

Sophomores may take 1 AP course; juniors may take 2; seniors may take 3.

AP Scores

All students enrolled in an AP course (through both MHS and VHS) are required to take the AP examination in May.

2019-2020 COVID Response

The final grade for spring 2020 semester classes was determined by Q3 grade. Pass/Fail spring semester classes were given credit (CR) or no credit (NC). Spring semester classes were not included in the GPA. Final grades for year long classes were determined by Q1, Q2, & Q3 grades (40%, 40%, 20%). Q4 was awarded credit/no credit for all classes.

2020-2021 COVID Response

On September 16, 2020, MHS began in a fully remote setting. On November 5, 2020, students moved to a hybrid model with two cohorts and each cohort in the building two mornings a week. On April 26, 2021, students returned to school for full days five days a week. Some students chose to be remote for the full year.

2021-2022 COVID Response

Maynard High School was open fully in-person for all students with no online or remote learning option.
