To continue to try to gather what the community thinks about this topic, Phil P. mentioned they could put out a community survey providing the local tax increase difference between gas-fired and geothermal and have the question of which system they would choose. The SBC agreed with putting out a community survey.

Mary B. had a question on incentives for Seniors on fixed income as it relates to the local tax implications caused by the borrowing for the project in the event the project is approved to move forward.

M. Stevens suggested the importance of needing to do a good job at selling the school project as a whole and not focusing on the HVAC system.
