

## AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

Applications for the following scholarships are now available in the Guidance Office. If you feel that you meet the eligibility requirements and are interested in applying, come by the Guidance Office. Applications are on file in the College Information Section for the following:

**NAME: APIA SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship is available to Asian and Pacific Islander students. You must display financial need and have a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or better. You must also apply for the FAFSA by early 2020. APPLICATION DEADLINE: Online by January 22, 2020

**NAME: THE DIRK DERRICK CAR & TRUCK ACCIDENT INJURY SCHOLARSHIP**

This is a \$1,000 scholarship provided by the Derrick Law Firm. To apply, your life must have been altered due to an injury from a car or truck accident. It can be your own injury, that of a loved one, or an influential individual. You must submit an essay to explain how the accident has affected you. To apply, you will need to take \$20 for the State Board fee, unofficial transcript, driver's license and social security card and write an essay on why you want to pursue a career in beauty. You can also apply for a \$1,000 scholarship. For the \$100 application fee to be waived, you must attend the Preview Day.

To apply, you must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or greater and an ACT scores of at least 18. You must also be planning to attend a 4-year college/university or a vocational-technical school.
