Goal 1: Academic Growth for Every Child.

- Every student will meet or exceed their projected MAP growth score in reading and math.
- All grade level cohorts will score above the MAP national average in the areas of reading and math.

Goal 2: Provide a Consistent and Enhanced Curriculum Across Grade Levels

- Maintain alignment of the district curriculum with priority Illinois Learning Standards.
- Continue to expand the “Dual Language” program.
- Continue to enhance the Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math (STEAM) curriculum.
- Explore options to create the gifted education program.

Goal 3: Increase Parent and Community Involvement and Awareness

- Increase parent communication emphasizing the need for their involvement in their child’s education.
- Increase community awareness regarding school and District activities.
- Expand parent-advisory committee to include more parents.

Goal 4: Provide Fiscal Responsibility and Transparency

- Maintain collective fund balances in accordance with board policy.
- Retain no less than \$6 million dollars in the Working Cash Fund.
